WORKS ADMISSION

Conferences

The main conferences of the event will be requested by the Scientific Committee to outstanding specialists of the different topics and workshops. However, those interested in contributing to a certain theme can make the request to the Organizing Committee, which will assess the proposal with satisfaction and respond as soon as possible. These should be sent in Spanish, Portuguese or English, with a maximum extension of 10 pages, a sheet format of 8½ x 11, Times

New Roman font of 12 points, single line spacing and 2.5 cm margins. The papers will begin with the title (no more than 15 words), the authors and their respective institutions, in addition to the complete postal address and the electronic address of the corresponding author. They will contain an Abstract of no more than 250 words, five (5) keywords, followed by the Introduction, Development, Conclusions and References. You can include the necessary tables and figures.

SHORT PAPERS

They will be sent in Spanish, Portuguese or English, with a maximum extension of 5 pages, a sheet format of 8½ x 11, Times New Roman font of 12 points, single line spacing and 2.5 cm margins. The papers will begin with the title (no more than 15 words), the authors and their respective institutions, in addition to the complete postal address and the electronic address of the corresponding author. The Abstract will be no more than 250 words, four (4) keywords, a brief Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results and Discussion, with a maximum of two (2) figures or two (2) tables. In total you may include up to five (5) bibliographical references. Do not use footnotes.

In the case of the producers, their papers will have as a distinctive characteristic a maximum of up to 3 pages that includes, in addition to the summary, information on how the paper was developed, the main results and conclusions.

The Scientific Committee of the Convention will select a group of these short papers to be exposed, orally and in person, in the various workshops of the event, which will be communicated to the authors in advance, in order to guarantee their direct participation in the **Plaza America Convention Center**. The rest of the selected papers will be exhibited in the form of posters, although the presentation of videos of no more than 10 minutes in duration is also invited, after consultation with the Organizing Committee of the Convention. These papers will be exhibited virtually, on a platform to which all the participants of the event will have access and during all the days in which it takes place. Details about internet links for the online modality will be communicated later.

The reception of all the papers will be until July 15, 2022. The papers sent after the mentioned date may be evaluated for acceptance, but the Organizing Committee will not guarantee that they will be included in the scientific reports of the event.

BUSINESS ROUND

A Business Round will be held for the coordination of commercial actions between Scientific, Academic and Business Sector Institutions. The services to be agreed will be academic, undergraduate, postgraduate, specialized courses, events, consultancies, scientific-technical projects, technology transfer and technical assistance, as well as products derived from science and innovation.

TECHNICAL TOURS

On October 9, prior to the start of the event, technical tours will be organized to productive and science and technology entities of the state and non-state sector, of Matanzas and Mayabeque provinces, to show the results of the science and innovation activity based on national food production and territorial development.

Tour 1. Visit to Santa Cruz del Norte Agricultural Enterprise, Santa Cruz del Norte municipality, Mayabeque province

- **Dairy 1 from Vía Blanca Farm**

The dairy is located in Vía Blanca, with an excellent view of the surroundings and enriching the landscape of the coastal area. Due to the technologies and forms of production used in it, its incorporation as a tourist trail is intended based on the principle of low-carbon ecological livestock. It will be possible to observe the general management and feeding strategies of a herd

of Taíno breed from Cuba, an excellent and beautiful animal, with magnificent productive results, in comparison with other genotypes. The work to improve this zoogenetic resource, the use of silvopastoral systems, as well as the production and use of protein plants for animal feeding will also be appreciated. The products derived from this scenario (milk, cheese and cuts of meat) are of excellent quality and part of them are marketed under the AGROFRESK brand.

- **Diversified Farm of food production with more Science**

The Diversified Farm, also located on Via Blanca, is the result of the chaining of science, the socialist state company and a private producer. It includes a pig farm with the dark layer genotype, a highly hardy animal, ideal for production systems with low inputs and high quality lean meat. The preserve acquires piglets produced in a multiplier center of the same company and contributes to local self-sufficiency. On the other hand, the farm has demonstrative areas of sustainable production of rabbits, quail and fish. The latter in a natural lake with an incredible view and in constant exchange with nature. The stage also has a space for the production of alternative foods with the use of local resources and in harmony with the environment. Both scenarios show the resilience and sustainability of livestock systems.

Tour 2. Visit to a farm and a science, technology and innovation center in Matanzas province

- **Coincidencia farm, from the Cooperative of Credits and Strengthened Services Nicomedes Nodarse, Jovellanos municipality. Producer: Hector Correa Almeida**

The Coincidencia farm has an extension of 23 ha, located in the Habana-Matanzas plain, on a Brown soil with carbonate, between Coliseo and Jovellanos towns. It is distinguished by its high biodiversity of plant and animal species, which makes it a genetic preserve. It shows spatial and temporal diversification of agroforestry systems, where species with different purposes are blend: fruit trees, timber, forages, organic production of vegetables, vegetables, tubers, coffee production and molasses. The production of food and energy is integrated with the use of bioproducts. Family heritage, where the art of pottery and agriculture converge in favor of agroecology, diversification and resilience.

- **Visit to the Pasture and Forage Experimental Station “Indio Hatuey”, Perico municipality**

Scientific institution belonging to Matanzas University, with 60 years of experience and whose mission is: To contribute, through scientific activity and innovation, to sustainable local development through agroecological models that integrate food and energy production, aimed at promoting economic development, care for the environment and human well-being. This institution, since its foundation and, especially, in recent years, has faced the challenge of rapidly increasing food production to contribute to reducing the country's dependence on imported food, and to the food security of the population. In this sense, it has different agricultural technologies, derived from research, which have made it possible to increase the production of peasants and producers from different territories of the country.
